


#### What is an Officiating Camp?


- Objective is to hone your skills as an official



  - Avoid movement of head when shuffling

- Stationary at line at until process of catch is completed
  - Avoid movement of head when shuffling
- Discuss in pre-game how you are going to communicate non-verbally with your deep flank
  - Ex. 15 yard crossing pattern that is close to OB
