

Rule book Clarification....

Rule—

1.8.3 Flags made by NFL Flag, USA Football and Shruumz that are unaltered from original manufacture size will be legal

2.13.2 When the ball is snapped.... without first being passed, tossed or pitched (these words are missing and should be in the rule book) forward or backward

5.3.2 Interpretation --- this does not mean that snaps cannot be taken under center. A violation should **not be** called unless multiple players are crowding the center in an attempt to deceive who will receive the snap. One (1) yard off the LOS to take a snap under center will be legal if the above-mentioned violation is not committed.

6.6.8 Words should have been removed .. (the is confusing as tackling is already addressed in 4). Please disregard these words

6.6.13 is missing from the rule book dated March 18. It should read...

Holding- the foul of holding is called when the defender impedes, delays or redirects the progress of the ballcarrier, in an attempt to de-flag that ball carrier. The action of grabbing and immediately releasing the clothing (or other) of the ball carrier, that does not impede, delay or redirect the ball carrier is not a penalty. **Penalty – Holding, live ball, 10 yards, spot of the foul.** The offense can elect to decline this penalty if the end of the related run results in a greater distance the penalty.
